SERVICE AND OUTREACH PROGRAMS

Meals on Wheels – delivering hot meals to seniors weekly

Food Pantry – regular food collection plus an annual “Fill-a-Bag” program that provides over 130 full bags of groceries

St. Francis Soup Kitchen – we serve the meal four times a year
