Trinity Lutheran Preschool is a time for children to share, observe, experiment, create, discover, and express themselves through a flexible program. It is a time of wonder, accomplishment and FUN!

When the children arrive at school they have “free play” time. During this time children are able to choose what they want to play with from the various activity centers available to them. These centers may include blocks, housekeeping, books, art, puzzles, manipulatives and science. “Free time” also allows for social, language, cognitive and motor skills development. There is interaction with the teachers and with other children.

The children gather for circle time activities. These include checking on the daily helper assignments, calendar, weather, and pledging the flag. At this time activities that might take place include; numbers, letters, discoveries, concepts such as big/little, more/less, stories, songs, finger plays, discussion of holidays or important events and sharing.

Snack is provided each day. Snacks, at times, are made by the children or provided by parents for special occasions.

Throughout the year we will introduce numbers, colors and shapes, along with seasonal, holiday and other themes – such as fire safety and dental health. Special visitors may come to present special programs. Name recognition is ongoing. Outdoor activities may include playground, blacktop play and observing nature. Field trips might include the pumpkin patch and the library.

The school year ends with a program given by the children for parents and friends and a family picnic.
