## Kindergarten Readiness Program

The Trinity Lutheran Kindergarten Readiness Program provides an opportunity for students to experience a five day academic program, beyond preschool, that allows for the introduction of, exposure to, and practice in skills necessary for success in Kindergarten. Children must have completed a four year old preschool program or be Kindergarten eligible.

Upon arrival at school, students will begin their day gathered together in circle time to pledge the flag, identify classroom helpers and complete jobs, practice important calendar skills, and identify the weather. While together the class will review previously introduced concepts, be introduced to new concepts, as well as learn content within the thematic unit.

Throughout the school day, the children will be engaged in large group instruction, small group lessons, and independent work in language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, fine arts, as well as continuing to strengthen their social, fine and gross motor skills.

Outdoor activity time is provided on our playground and black top space, weather permitting. Children will also have the opportunity for dramatic play, blocks, puzzles, and artistic expression within their school day.

Snack is provided each day. Snacks, at times are made by the children or provided by parents for special occasions.

Conferences will be held in October, and then again in February, to provide an opportunity for parents and teachers to share and discuss their child's progress.
