God, who is rich in mercy, loved us even when we were dead in sin, and made us alive together with Christ.





water only but with the water and the blood. And the Spirit is the one that testifies, for the Spirit is the truth.




the true Paschal Lamb who gave himself to take away our sin; who in dying has destroyed death, and in rising has brought us to eternal life.
